 - Only includes classes taken in 9th-12th grades.
 - Middle school classes earn credit and count toward graduation, but do NOT calculate into the student's high school GPA.
- Numeric grades on the transcript are the actual grades the student earned.
 - Extra Quality Points (EQPs) are only added to the overall weighted GPA and includes the following EQPs:
 - Pre-IB, Magnet and Honors level courses earn 0.5 EQPs
 - AB/IP & World Languages levels IV-V earn 1.0 EQPs
 - The unweighted GPA is cumulative without EQPs.
